The Warren County Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing in the Warren County Government Center on Tuesday, September 15, 2020 beginning at 7:30 PM on the following items. In the event of inclement weather and the hearing is postponed, it will be held the following Tuesday.

Ordinance to Amend and Re-Ordain Section 82-4 of the Warren County Code to have South River Estates Sanitary District be authorized to apply a Construction Road Use Fee

Ordinance to Amend and Re-Ordain Section 177-3 of the Warren County Code to add Clear Back Subdivision to the list of locations within Warren County where the Recreational Shooting of Firearms is Prohibited

Conditional Use Permit 2020-07-04 – Mario and Wendy Loundermon for a Short-Term Tourist Rental. The property is located at 200 Valley Retreat Road and identified as tax map 26C-1, parcel 14A. It is zoned Residential One (R-1) and located in the Fork Magisterial District.

PASSAGE A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN ESTIMATED MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF UP TO \$5,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION SCHOOL REFUNDING BONDS, OF THE COUNTY OF WARREN, VIRGINIA AND PROVIDING FOR THE FORM AND DETAILS THEREOF: Proposed passage of a resolution authorizing the issuance of an estimated maximum amount of \$5,000,000 principal amount of general obligation school refunding bonds of the County. The proposed uses for which more than ten percent of the bond proceeds are expected to be used are the refinancing of the outstanding principal amount of the \$7,365,000 Lease Revenue Refunding Bond, Series 2013B issued by the Industrial Development Authority of the Town of Front Royal and the County of Warren, Virginia to refinance improvements to Luray Avenue Middle School in the County plus other capital improvements and related equipment for school facilities, all of which constitute capital projects for public school purposes.
