

# Winter 2021 Scavenger Hunt at the Park Clues:

- Park Clue #1: This property is well suited to become parkland, given its rolling topography, adjacency to the Shenandoah River, wooded areas and far-reaching views. However, this 219 acre property is limited in terms of building development due to steep slopes, limestone Karst topography and the presence of the endangered Madison Cave Isopod in the western edge of the site.
- Park Clue #2: This 60 Acre Park was established in 1943 and is in the Shenandoah Magisterial District. This park showcases the majority of the community's recreational amenities and baseball fields.
- Park Clue #3: This 3 Acre Park was established in 1974 and includes numerous amenities to include a wooden playground, and fully accessible playground and an outdoor harmony music park.
- Park Clue #4: Located in the Fork Magisterial District, this 12 acre park was established in 2009 as a multi-purpose facility. It features unique attractions such as a historic rock wall, marking the edge of a bygone road and beautiful views of the Shenandoah River.
- Park Clue #5: Established in 1993, this 3 acre park is located in the Happy Creek Magisterial District and is dedicated to a community leader that was instrumental in forming the P&R Youth basketball program. This park includes many recreational amenities including an outdoor harmony music park.
- Park Clue #6: This 25 acre parcel of land was purchased in 1997 from a bankruptcy court for development of a community-oriented athletic park in the Fork Magisterial District.
- Park Clue #7: Located in the North River Magisterial District, this 10 acre park was established in the 1960's. It includes a ballfield complex, the former C.A.P location and playground.
